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### Natural English - Chunking (Pause) I.

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### **Natural English - Adding Stress**




















### **Example #2: Reading Discussion Questions**

### How to build self-confidence

Self-confidence: one's belief that they can meet all the demands of a task. Some people are born with it, and everyone else is out of luck, right? Wrong! Self-confidence is not something people are born with, like their height or hair color. It's a skill that anyone can start practicing today.

One simple self-confidence builder is positive self-talk. What you say to yourself influences how you feel about yourself. Telling yourself "I can't do anything right" or asking "Why did I even try?" could ruin you. Instead, if you get a bad grade on a test, try saying "I'll do better next time."

Rather than focusing on your failure, identify ways that you can improve, and try again.

Another way to boost your confidence is to believe in yourself. Studies show that believing you can do something can increase your chance of success. If you put in the work to learn how to do something, believe in your ability. Don't let doubt steal your energy and motivation away.  $\leftarrow$ 

One of the ugliest enemies of self-confidence is comparing yourself to others. Thinking that you are better than other people won't give you confidence. Instead, it will make you arrogant. And thinking you are worse than others won't make you humble; it will fill you with envy. Fight back by counting your blessings. Keep a gratitude journal and write down all the <a href="thinks">that you're</a> thankful for.\*



- Ask for specifics (use the word "strategy" / verb tenses...)35






